The Edmonton Police Service is writing in support of the above applications seeking Public Interest status under provisions of the *Broadcasting Act* as Avis de Récherche TV and All Points Bulletin TV. These applications propose a nation-wide public security network to bring accurate, timely and truly informative programming on the topic to Canadians covering education, enforcement and investigative activities.

Communication to the public is one of the key challenges to policing in 2007. Television can provide timely relevant information on topics such as identity theft, internet crimes, and public safety in general including Crime Stoppers and missing person reports and, most importantly, keep these messages in front of the public.
