I have reviewed the proposal to make All Points Bulletin TV and Avis de Recherche TV available in many regions of the country, including the Province of Saskatchewan and the City of Regina.

The Regina Police Service strongly endorses open, transparent communication in the belief that informed people can participate more fully and effectively in their communities. In today's world, traditional methods of information sharing through local news media continue to be important, but are being complemented by new media technologies such as web sites and electronic messaging. A television service dedicated to public safety would not only add another avenue of informing and educating the public about safety and security matters, but could also be an effective investigative tool in missing or wanted persons cases and in unsolved crimes. Through this service, communities would be better informed and could become safer and more secure.
