The Saint John Police Force views the service proposed by All Points Bulletin as a very important communication tool with a tremendous amount of potential. A television network dedicated solely to law enforcement agencies across the country will provide police agencies with a direct link to the public to instantly share vital information on suspects, missing persons and other law enforcement issues that require public attention. This service could result in significant investigational consequences.

Limited resources and financial restraints prevent many police organizations from utilizing the TV as a means to inform and educate the public on crime prevention issues.
